## Volunteers are needed to help clean up Lake Berryessa!

*Divers, canoeists, kayakers, and shoreline folks welcome*

The event is part of **Coastal Cleanup Day**, a statewide and international effort to clean trash and debris from coasts, bays, creeks, rivers, and lakes. For the past seven years, Napa Dive and Sport, along with many concerned people in the community, have been cleaning up Lake Berryessa. Last year, over 100 volunteers collected 900 pounds of trash and 1,710 pounds of recyclables from the lake and its shoreline!

### CLEANUP LOCATION

Volunteers will meet at **8:45 am** at the **Pope Creek Bridge**. From **9 am** until **noon**, divers will clean the bottom of the lake, while others help clean the shore and sort recyclables.
